



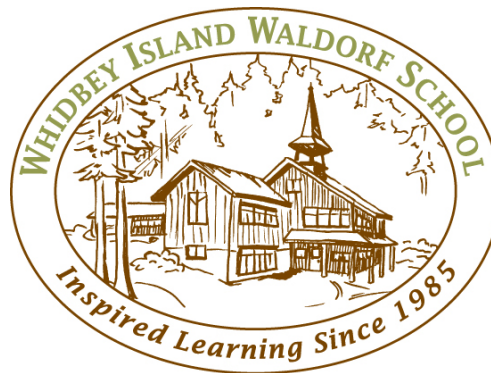
William Dolde, Instructor
